Dear Brockton Public Schools Staff and Families,

As a reminder, if an inclement weather event occurs, we will continue to operate under the remote learning model regardless of weather conditions, except for a significant power outage.

When a transition to hybrid learning takes place and an inclement weather event occurs, we will operate under a full remote learning school day. The only exception to this process which could cause a school delay or cancellation would be if a major power outage were to occur.

This protocol, under the guidance of the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, will eliminate the need to make up inclement weather days at the end of the school year. Attendance will be taken on these days and students will need to log into their teachers' remote learning sessions. In any case that remote learning cannot occur, school days will need to be made up at the end of the school year.

Any school delay or cancellation due to a significant power outage, weather event, or any other unforeseen emergency will be communicated to our school community via voice/text delivery, on our website, and via notification to the local news feed.
